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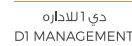
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Every Visitor Has Their Own ADIHEX

The Founder's Office Introduces Sheikh Zayed's Enduring Legacy to Public



The Founder's Office pavilion at the 23rd edition of then Abu Dhabi International Hunting and Equestrian Exhibition (ADIHEX) provides visitors with an insightful glimpse into the legacy of the late Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, the Founding Father of the UAE. This year marks the office's inaugural participation in the exhibition, which is taking place at ADNEC Centre Abu Dhabi until September 6. The event is organized by ADNEC Group, a Modon company, in strategic partnership with the Emirates Falconers' Club.

The participation aims to make Sheikh Zayed's legacy a living, publicly accessible part of history, beyond mere documentation.

A Legacy for Generations

The Founder's Office, linked to the Ministry of Presidential Affairs, was established in 2017 in preparation for the Year of Zayed in 2018.

Its mission is to preserve and pass on Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan's legacy to future generations by collecting and documenting accurate information about his contributions. The pavilion features a coffee corner in partnership with "Beit Al Qahwa," serving coffee made from Sheikh Zayed's original recipe. Visitors can scan a QR code for details on the recipe. It also includes a traditional falconry majlis and a replica of Sheikh Zayed's own majlis.

In the centre of the majlis, a screen showcases various scenes featuring Sheikh Zayed, may God have mercy on him. One notable scene from 1981 depicts him with purebred Arabian horses. Additionally, there is a display of artifacts from his majlis.

Core Values

The pavilion walls feature phrases that highlight Sheikh Zayed's personality and the core

values of his legacy. These principles, reflected in his words and actions, continue to resonate deeply with the people and are essential to the UAE's present and future.

The Founder's Office distilled a core set of values from Sheikh Zayed's vision, providing a reference for current and future generations. Special panels in Arabic and English highlight the importance of "building and developing people," reflecting Sheikh Zayed's belief that humans are the UAE's greatest asset. He focused on meeting their basic needs and empowering them, placing special emphasis on women and youth.

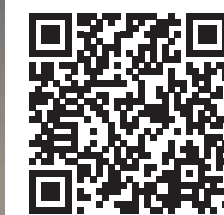
The pavilion features an interactive corner for visitors, where a staff member takes each visitor's photo, writes their name on it, and displays it on a special board alongside other visitors' photos.



AL AIN 2026

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The Abu Dhabi International Hunting and Equestrian Exhibition (ADIHEX) features a diverse array of companies and organisations specialising in veterinary and health fields. These exhibitors are presenting cutting-edge solutions for falcons, horses, camels, and domestic and predatory animals. The offerings include diagnostic and treatment technologies, nutritional supplements, and products aimed at animal care and reproduction.

The increasing interest in integrated services for animal health is evident, driven by the demands of falconers, breeders, and horse and camel owners. The exhibition serves as a key platform for specialists to showcase their latest solutions, exchange knowledge, and connect with clients to better understand sector needs. Held before the equestrian season, ADIHEx offers companies and breeders an opportunity to plan and prepare their services early.

IFT: Specialised Veterinary Products

IFT is participating in ADIHEX for the first time, showcasing an array of veterinary products and medicines for falcons, camels, and horses, as well as offerings for dogs and cats. Fadi Magdy, the company's production line manager, highlighted that their involvement in the exhibition offers a valuable opportunity to engage with visitors and professionals and to present their therapeutic and preventive solutions for various animal species.

He elaborated that the company's product line includes vaccinations for camels and horses, anti-inflammatory medications, treatments for joint inflammation in horses, and supplements designed to boost immunity and stimulate appetite in dogs and cats.

The company focuses on falcons, providing products for kidney and liver health, appetite improvement, and feather maintenance tailored to birds of prey. Their products are made in the UAE and India, offering a diverse range of options for breeders and specialists.



Mobile Veterinary Clinics

The exhibition highlights mobile veterinary clinics equipped with advanced medical equipment and tools to conduct examinations, perform delicate surgical procedures, and administer first aid to falcons. Among these is the "Ger Veterinary Therapy" clinic, which showcases a fully equipped vehicle with an operating room, a preparation area, and a post-operative care unit.

Dr. Mohammed Al Sheikh, a veterinarian at the clinic, noted that it also offers medical consultations and 24/7 emergency services, allowing the clinic to travel to clients' locations to provide essential treatment for falcons.

The Najm Suhail Veterinary Clinic also offers mobile services equipped with diagnostic and first aid equipment, along with special offers for exhibition visitors, including 10 services for AED 250.

Dr. Ahmed Al-Shiwi explained that the mobile clinic aims to reach falcon breeders and owners by providing fast, advanced veterinary services. He noted that the medical team has saved the lives of hundreds of falcons and that services include vaccinations, examinations, and treatments using the latest diagnostic equipment.

Integrated Veterinary Solutions

German Standard Group (GSG) has participated in the exhibition since its inception, showcasing medicines, treatment services, and veterinary solutions for various animals. Dr. Taha Mohamed, the Marketing and Sales Director, noted that GSG began with blood analysis and diagnostic equipment for pets and later expanded to include therapeutic services, nutritional supplements, and animal reproduction solutions.

The company specialises in tools and supplies for embryo transfer, artificial insemination, and semen transfer for sheep, horses, and camels, enhancing animal production and reproduction. It also provides advanced diagnostic equipment, including MRI, X-ray, and blood analysis devices, for accurate veterinary diagnoses and treatment selection.

Dr. Mohamed highlighted that the variety of solutions demonstrates the company's commitment to a full system that includes examinations, diagnoses, treatment, nutritional supplements, and animal reproduction and production.

New Products for Dogs and Cats

Kilato Health has participated in the exhibition for the second time, presenting a wide array of nutritional supplements and healthcare products for horses and camels. The company is also preparing to unveil new products specifically designed for dogs and cats. Dr. Osama Fahmy, the director of Kilato Health, highlighted that the exhibition's timing, just before the equestrian season, offers exhibitors and



traders a significant opportunity to strategize and refine their plans and offerings. He added that their successful participation in the previous edition motivated them to return this year with an even larger booth.

Kilato Health offers around 32 equine health products, including solutions for muscles, respiratory, hoof, and digestive health, as well as nutritional supplements for production horses. The company prioritises preventative care and is expanding its offerings with seven new products for dogs and cats.

Fahmy highlighted the growing participation by companies and visitors at the exhibition, reinforcing its role as a key platform for professionals in equestrian sports, falconry, and veterinary care. The range of exhibits showcases veterinary services, from daily care to advanced diagnostics, to meet the needs of breeders and specialists. From First Glance to Right Decision: How to Choose the Perfect Falcon?

Selecting a falcon is not a casual decision; it is a journey that begins with understanding the bird's characteristics and capabilities and extends to considering the falconer's needs, experience, and intended use. At the Abu Dhabi International Hunting and Equestrian Exhibition (ADIHEX) 2026, falconry enthusiasts, exhibitors, and experts come together to showcase a variety of falcon species, elucidate the differences among them, and assist visitors in making informed choices.

How does a falconer arrive at their decision? What criteria influence their selection? Considerations such as breed, age, and size are crucial. Additionally, factors like fitness, health, and training potential play significant roles in the selection process. All these questions highlight that choosing a falcon is an art that demands expertise and knowledge. The decision-making process is influenced by several factors that both falconers and prospective buyers should be well-acquainted with, and these considerations are widely recognised among those who are passionate about this field.

Numerous Criteria

Omar Naseeb, an exhibitor from the Kingdom of Bahrain, asserts that the selection process for a falcon is influenced by several criteria,

including shape, colour, size, and weight. He noted: "The falcon's structure and body are crucial factors, along with the intended purpose of the purchase and the budget set aside for acquiring the bird. Some falcons can cost over three million dirhams, while others may be priced around ten thousand dirhams, so it's expected that there will be a significant disparity between them."

Fares Al Mazrouei stated that the selection process for a falcon follows specific criteria and standards, with key factors including size, colour, weight, as well as the width of the falcon, its shoulders, head, and feet. He elaborated: "There are notable differences among various types of falcons. The peregrine falcon, for instance, is relatively small, adapts well to heat, is exceptionally fast, and can be found in the Middle East and Africa. In contrast, the gyrfalcon thrives in colder climates, such as

Russia and Siberia, and is larger. The saker falcon is particularly recognised for its speed and endurance."

Key factors

Abbas Ashour (Abu Fadel) explains that the distinction of a falcon is based on size, colour, and structure. He notes that a falconer's preferences and the purpose of acquiring a bird are key factors in the selection process. Some favour the peregrine falcon, while others choose the gyrfalcon or hybrids. Colour also plays an important role, with options such as super white, ultra white, and golden falcons being popular.

Ahmed Al Mansouri, a falcon breeder, emphasised that key factors in selecting a falcon include the bird's head shape, size, and colour. He stated that speed, strength, and beauty are critical qualities.



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Sharjah Safari

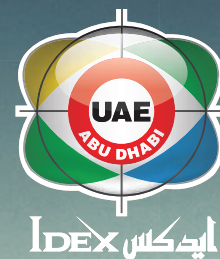

The art of Al-Nahma captivates visitors at the exhibition. A group of performers showcases traditional songs and sea chants to engage the audience and introduce them to this unique art form.

Al Nahma is regarded as one of the essential traditional folk arts in the UAE, with historical ties to the sea and pearl diving. Sailors would perform Al-Nahma during their long voyages to ease the rigors of their work, uplift their spirits, and foster a sense of camaraderie. This art form is characterised by group performances, typically led by a single individual known as the Nahham.

Al-Ayyala Band

Visitors to ADIHEX often gather around the Mubarak Al Otaiba Al Ayyala Band to cap-

ture their performances. The band showcases traditional Al Ayyala songs, featuring drums, cymbals, and frame drums such as the Tar and Daf. Performers greet the audience and engage in "Wanna," a vocal improvisation typically composed of Nabati poetry. The Wanna often occurs at the end of the performance and involves exchanges between two performers.

Ghana Verses Japan

The Japanese pavilion features performances of traditional Japanese heritage and folklore by artists from Tokyo, showcasing dances related to Japan's history. The aim is to introduce visitors to Japanese art and integrate it with Emirati culture. Additionally, the African percussion group "Happy Drums" from Ghana, led by director Kodzo Maihiso, performs songs and dances reflecting Ghanaian heritage, with a team of 40 performers, each with a specific role.
